Participants will practice public speaking, learn about how state policy affects food systems in Colorado, and learn policy advocacy skills to share their stories and help change policy in Colorado.

Program Includes:

- 6 trainings covering policy and public speaking (online; we will try and support if you do not have access to the internet)
- 1 field trip to the Colorado State Capitol in Denver (hotel, child care and travel expenses covered)
- Interpretation if requested
- A \$20 stipend per training will be included for participants
- A chance to make changes in Colorado food policy!
